The scholarship committee wants to help support the future endeavors of young women who exhibit the organization's values to bring together women of diverse accomplishments and experiences, directing them to policy-making opportunities for the promotion of the interests, conditions and positions of women.

- **Qualifications:** a female high school senior that is currently enrolled at a public or private school in an East End township: Fisher's Island to Riverhead, Eastport-Manorville to Montauk; and who will be enrolled at a post-secondary educational or career/technical training program this Fall. Application deadline: midnight on Sunday, April 28, 2024.
- **Award:** \$1,000

Submit a complete file including each of the following items.

1. Application
2. An essay (1000 words) on "What does leadership mean to me?"
3. Two letters of recommendation from
 - a. a faculty member/leader/coach from their school, and
 - b. from a community person/employer
4. High School transcript
5. Resume

Applications will be reviewed and scored based on academic preparation, community/ school Involvement, recommendations and the essay.

Winners will be contacted on or before May 7, 2024. Each scholarship recipient, and up to two designees, will be honorary guests at our May Meeting: May 15, 2024. After dinner there will be a brief presentation of the scholarships during which each recipient will be asked to make a quick address to the membership and attendees highlighting themselves and/or their future plans. The event will be held at an East End restaurant/location, to be announced.
